Please accept reusable coffee cups



Getting reusables back on the menu with a Contactless Coffee

To help businesses take action to reduce waste, plastic pollution campaigning organisation, City to Sea have created a simple guide to help them safely accept reusable coffee cups.

- **Step 1:** Customer places their clean reusable cup (lid off) on a designated tray and steps back two metres.
- **Step 2:** The barista takes the tray with the customer's cup over to the coffee machine, extracts the coffee into a normal crockery cup or espresso shot glass and steams the milk as required.
- **Step 3:** Without touching the customer's reusable cup, the attendant pours the coffee and milk into the customer's cup, takes the tray back to the till and steps back two metres.
- **Step 4:** The customer steps forward to pick up their coffee cup and places the lid back on themselves.

Other options include the customer placing their reusable cup inside a large ceramic cup provided by the vendor – repeat as above using the ceramic cup in place of the tray.
